- 6) Aggravated Assault An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault usually is accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm. Smple assaults are excluded.
- 7) Burglary The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft. Offenses counted on UCR forms as burglary are: unlawful entry of a structure with intent to commit a larceny or felony; breaking and entering with intent to commit a larceny; housebreaking; safecracking; and all attempts to commit the foregoing offenses.
- 8) Arson Any willful or malicious burning or attempt to burn, with or without the intent to defraud, a dwelling house, public building, motor vehicle, personal property of another, etc.
- 9) Hate Orime Is a criminal offense committed against a person or property which is motivated in attitude toward a group of persons based on their race, gender, religion, disability, sexual orientation or ethnicity/national origin.
- D. The Campus Assessment, Response and Evaluation (C.A.R.E.) Team are responsible for reviewing, assessing, acting and following up on reports and incidents of individuals of concern at LCCC.
- E A student, staff, faculty or community member that is exhibiting disruptive, disturbing or disturbed behavior as determined by CARE Team threat assessment procedure.
- F T The term used in this procedure only that refers to an individual of concern that has been deemed an imminent threat to the safety of the LCCC Community; or an individual suspected of the commission of a crime enumerated in the Clery Act who is not allowed to enter any LCCC campus or property.
- A. Under FERPA individuals of concern that have been determined by the C.A.R.E. Team to be an imminent threat to self and/or others will be trespassed from the college in accordance with Procedure 3.20P Student Rights and Responsibilities.
